KS4 Results 2011

This year Sandhurst School students have achieved the highest results in our history.

We are all delighted with the achievements of the class of 2011 and extremely proud of our students for gaining such excellent results. There are wonderful stories at all levels. Particular congratulations go to Michael Bird, Charlotte Batchelor, Tim Jackson and Laura Raymen who attained A* or A grades in all ten of their subjects. Two of our year 11 students took AS courses this year and they both passed these exams.

The headline figures are as follows and represent a significant improvement on previous years:

- The proportion achieving 5+A*-C grades has risen to **94%** (compared to 59% in 2009 and 79% in 2010).
- The average points score per student has increased to 480 (compared to 380 in 2009 and 443 in 2010).
- The percentage of students achieving 5+A*-C including English and maths is 52% (improved from 47% in 2009 and 50% in 2010).
- The percentage of students passing 5 GCSEs is 100%.

These record results reflect both the hard work of students and the commitment and dedication of staff who have worked tirelessly to support students in their learning. We are thrilled by the achievements of our students and wish them all the very best for the future.
