Re: Sandhurst School Apps

This letter is a reminder about the different apps and online platforms we use at Sandhurst School. We've compiled the information to help you stay connected and informed about your child's learning, behaviour, and attendance.

Google Classroom

We use **Google Classroom** to set and track all homework assignments. This platform ensures your child has clarity on what's expected and often includes helpful resources. Once they've completed an assignment, they simply need to mark it as 'done' in the app or on the website.

You should have received an email from Google inviting you to join your child's classes. This will allow you to receive daily or weekly summaries of their homework. Please check your junk or spam folder if you haven't seen this email. Your child has been shown how to use Google Classroom, but they can speak to their tutor if they need a refresher.

When using the free mobile or tablet app, please remind your child to sign in with their school email address and password, not a personal Google account. If you want to change your settings, require support or find out more about Google Classroom please follow this [link](#).

Class Charts

We use **ClassCharts** to track student achievement and behaviour throughout the school day. This system allows us to securely share your child's behaviour and achievement with you. You can also view their timetable and receive email notifications if they are assigned a detention.

Each parent has a unique account, and you will receive an invitation with your access code in the next couple of hours, in case you need to reconnect with the app. If you have more than one child at the school, you can add additional codes once you've set up your account. Free mobile apps for iOS and Android are available.

Studybugs

Our system for reporting student absences is called **Studybugs**. It's an efficient and secure way to let us know if your child is ill and unable to attend school.
